II Job description for the posts of Professors

1. Managing the academic and administrative activities of the Centre.
2. Preparing annual work-plan for the Centre and ensure its effective implementation
3. Design, plan, co-ordinate and conduct training, research and consultancy activities including workshops and seminars for the Centre.
4. Organizing training programs as per training calendar.
5. Publish in reputed journals, researches conducted.
6. Liaisoning with National and International Institutions for image building of the Academy
7. Facilitate collaborative training, research and consultancy activities.
8. Promoting inter-disciplinary and inter-faculty training and research activities
9. Contribute to the professional development of the faculty of the Academy.
10. Conduct Impact assessment of training and research.
11. Preparation of Research and Training material.
12. Taking training sessions in the training programmes
13. Any other duties assigned from time to time.

III General Conditions:

1. The eligibility for the posts of Assistant, Associate and Professor is 3, 5 and 10 years experience respectively in Teaching, Training, & Research in the area of relevance with at least 2 publication for Assistant Professor 3 publication for Associate Professor and 5 publications for Professor. The recruitment will be made on all India basis.
2. Pay scales of Asst/Associate/Professor will be as per UGC as adopted in AP State Government Universities
3. The Candidates will be taken purely on contract/deputation bases initially for a period of 3 years which can be renewed based on performance and mutual agreement.
4. The salaries of above core faculty are paid from out of Recurring Grant released by MoRD, GoI, and will exist till as long as the grants are continued.
5. Residential accommodation on payment of normal rent in APARD Campus may be provided subject to availability.
6. Applicants who are employed should submit their applications through proper channel. The candidates should produce 'NOC' from parent organization at the time of interview.
7. Mere fulfillment of the qualifications prescribed does not entitle the candidate to be called for interview.
8. Canvassing in any form will be treated as disqualification.
